The passport fair will be held at the AAA Vestal offices in Vestal at 3701 Vestal Parkway East, Vestal, NY 13850 (in the Campus Plaza). Application forms will be available, and photos can be taken on site. You can also download a copy of the passport application in advance at <a href="https://www.travel.state.gov">www.travel.state.gov</a>.

Applicants should bring 1) an original or a certified copy of their birth certificate with a raised seal and a photocopy (front and back); 2) their photo ID and a photocopy (front and back); and 3) 2 checks to cover the passport application fees. Cash and credit cards will not be taken at the passport fair. Applicants should also have the places and dates of birth of their parents to correctly fill out the passport application. Children under 18 need to have their parents present for a passport application. Expedited applications cannot be processed at this passport fair.

The fees for passports are \$110 for adult applications and \$80 for children under the age of 16. Passport cards are also available, although they are only good for land and cruise ship travel. It is \$30 for adult passport cards and \$15 for children under the age of 16. There is a \$35 processing fee for each application. AAA staff will be available to take passport photos.
