RESOLUTION NO. 1

RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 576 OF 2023 LEVYING TAX PURSUANT TO SECTION 902 OF THE REAL PROPERTY TAX LAW AND OF THE BROOME COUNTY CHARTER ON THE CITY OF BINGHAMTON FOR 2024

WHEREAS, this County Legislature, by Resolution 573 of 2023, Levied Tax, Pursuant to Section 902 of the Real Property Tax Law and of the Broome County Charter, on the City of Binghamton for 2024, and authorized that the proper persons be authorized to execute and affix the proper Warrant to Tax Rolls thereof: County tax - \$11,039,489, and
