

Town of Union, New York Aging Demographics Fact Sheet

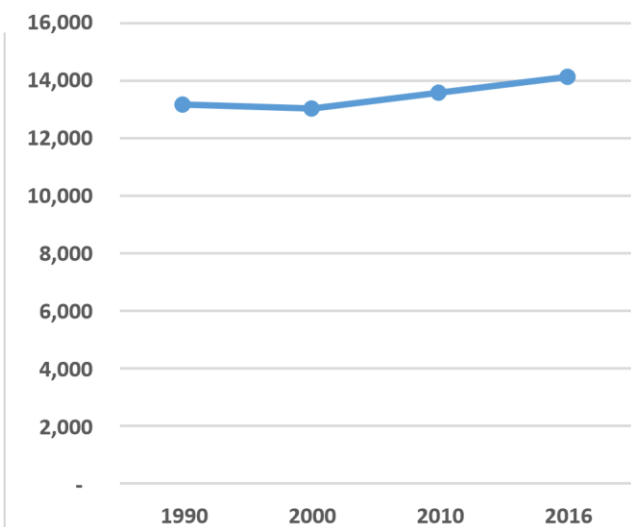


In 1990, residents age 60+ made up 22% of the Town of Union population. The 2016 Census estimates that residents 60+ made up 25.6% of the Town of Union population. Between 1990 and 2016 the 60+ population increased by 7.5% in the Town of Union.

2. Total Age Group Population Change 1990 to 2016

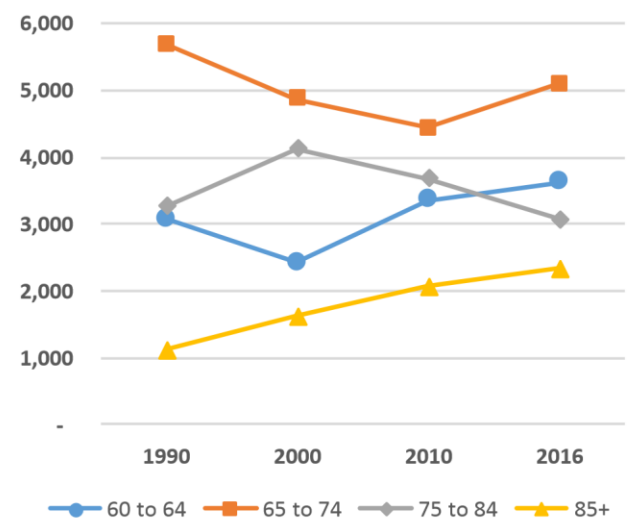


Chart 1: In the Town of Union, the aging population has increased from 13,140 in 1990 to 14,119 in 2016 (7.5% increase)
