The Broome County Sheriff's Office made the following earlier today:

On Tuesday morning December 13, 2022, at approximately 12:43 am, Broome County Sheriff Deputy observed a vehicle traveling on Broad Avenue near Bevier Street in the City of Binghamton that was reported as a stolen vehicle out of Syracuse N.Y. on November 23, 2022.

The Deputy followed the vehicle until backup units were summoned to his location. Deputies initiated a traffic stop on Prospect Street in the City of Binghamton. Upon pulling over to the side of the road, the operator immediately fled on foot. A short foot pursuit ensued and the operator, later identified as Roland McIntyre, was taken into custody a short distance away. McIntyre was found to be in possession of a small amount of cocaine on his person. Further investigation revealed that McIntyre possessed a bag in the motor vehicle that contained a collapsible Kel-Tec semi-automatic rifle, a loaded pistol magazine, and other miscellaneous items. McIntyre was transported to the Sheriff's Office for further investigation. He was processed on the charges listed below and was ultimately turned over to Binghamton Police Department personnel to await arraignment in the City of Binghamton Court.
