Felony Drug Charges for Methamphetamine and Other Drugs Following SIU Investigation in Endicott

(ENDICOTT, NY) On May 8, 2024 the Broome County Special Investigations Unit Task Force executed a search warrant at 516 Central St. Apt. 8, in the Village of Endicott.

The target of the search warrant was Gregg T. Stroud, age 55 of Endicott, NY, who was present during the execution of the warrant. During the search, the following items of evidence were located:

During the search, the following items of evidence were located:

- 50.2 grams of Methamphetamine
- 42 Multicolored pills that were determined to be Amphetamines
- 53 Adderall pills, a Schedule II Controlled Substance
- Scales and packaging used for the distribution of narcotics

As a result of the investigation, Gregg T. Stroud was arrested and charged with:

- Two Counts Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 3rd Degree, a Class B Felony
- Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 4th Degree, a Class C Felony
- Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 5th Degree, a Class D Felony
- Two Counts of Criminally Using Drug Paraphernalia in the 2nd Degree, Class A Misdemeanors

Stroud was transported to the Broome County Correctional Facility for processing and to await arraignment at Central Arraignment.

The Broome County Special Investigations Unit Task Force is comprised of the Broome County Sheriff's Office, the City of Binghamton Police Department, and the Village of Johnson City Police Department.
