

# **Application for Storm Debris Tipping Fee Waiver (Commercial Hauler)**

## Broome County Charter & Code:

The landfill charges set forth in Broome County Charter and Code 179-9 shall be waived for disposal of debris related to damage occurring during a natural or man-made disaster resulting in a declaration of a state of emergency by the County Executive.

## Emergency Services Certification:

The office of Emergency Services has declared that many municipalities (including the Village of Deposit, Town of Sanford, Town of Conklin, Kirkwood, Chenango, Vestal, Union, Village of Johnson City, City of Binghamton) and possibly others, have sustained damages to businesses, residential and/or public infrastructure with the flooding event of March 31 – April 2, 2005.

## Commercial Hauler Certification:

I certify that the debris that I'm delivering to the Broome County Landfill is material that was damaged as a result of the flooding event of March 31 – April 2, 2005 that I collected from my customers. Based on my own knowledge or the representations made by my customers, no insurance and/or emergency assistance (local, state, or federal) has or will be covering some or all of the normal tipping fees for this debris. I certify that no regular trash or garbage is mixed in with the storm debris.

**This waiver will be in effect for the time period of April 6 through April 19, 2005.**
