

## **Rabies Clinic to be Held in Town of Chenango**

The Broome County Health Department in conjunction with the Animal Aid and Relief Foundation (AARF) will be holding its first rabies clinic for 2010 on Saturday, February 20<sup>th</sup>, from 11:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. at the Town of Chenango Fire Station #2 located on 320 Kattelville Road, Binghamton, NY.

Anyone that has a dog, cat, or domesticated ferret that is at least three months old is welcome to bring their pet to the clinic. If your pet has had a rabies vaccination in the past, please be sure to bring their certificate of vaccination with you to the clinic so that your pet can receive a three year vaccination. Without this certification, your pet will receive a one year vaccination. There is no charge for the vaccination but a donation of \$5 per pet is appreciated. All pets will be vaccinated regardless of their owner's ability to donate. Pet owners must be in control of their pets while at the clinic.

A complete schedule of the Broome County Health Department and Animal Aid and Relief Foundation sponsored clinics will be available in mid to late March.
