The committee meeting was called to order by the Chairman at 4:04 PM. Ms. Buchta moved the agenda, seconded by Mr. Moran. The Committee took the following action with regard to the matters before it.

#7 RESOLUTION ADOPTING LOCAL LAW INTRODUCTORY NO. 8 OF 2010, ENTITLED: "A LOCAL LAW AMENDING CHAPTER 185 OF THE BROOME COUNTY CHARTER AND CODE TO ADD ARTICLE XVII-EXEMPTION FOR COLD WAR VETERANS"

Mr. Keibel stated this creates inequity and he would rather see something done on the federal level. Mr. Denk announced that this was brought forth by Ms. Messina and Mr. Diffendorf. Failed. Ayes-2, Nays-2 (Whalen, Keibel), Absent-1 (Nirchi)

#45 RESOLUTION ADOPTING LOCAL LAW INTRO. NO. 9 OF 2010, ENTITLED: "A LOCAL LAW AMENDING THE BROOME COUNTY CHARTER AND ADMINISTRATIVE CODE TO IMPOSE A LIMIT ON TERMS OF OFFICE TO A NUMBER OF TERMS TOTALING TEN CONSECUTIVE YEARS."

Mr. Klipsch stated he recommended this resolution as a result of conversation with his constituents and that it would give constituents an opportunity to vote on the matter. Mr. Keibel stated the voters already have a vote every two years. Failed. Ayes-1, Nays-3 (Whalen, Buchta, Keibel), Absent-1 (Nirchi)

#48 RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF THE OPERATION IMPACT VII PROGRAM GRANT FOR THE OFFICE OF THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY AND ADOPTING A PROGRAM BUDGET FOR 2010-2011

The Clerk announced that the District Attorney just received notice of this grant award and if they waited until next month to accept the grant the Office would not be entitled to the full amount. Carried for lateness. Ayes-4, Nays-0, Absent-1 (Nirchi)
