LOCAL LAW INTRO. NO. 5 of 2013

“A Local Law Amending Chapter 106-4(V)(9) of the Broome County Charter and Code Regarding the use of County property; traffic; parking (general)”

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Broome as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 106-4(V)(9) of the Broome County Charter and Code shall be is hereby amended as a new Subsection e to read as follows:

§106-4(V)(9) Use of County property; traffic; parking (general)

- e. Any vehicle left unattended and in violation of a metered or other parking regulation for a period of six (6) consecutive days is subject to the vehicle being immobilized by a wheel locking device. In addition to any fines associated with the parking violations, the violator must also remit the applicable fee of seventy five dollars (\$75.00) to remove the wheel locking device.

SECTION 2. This Local Law shall take effect upon filing with the Secretary of State.
