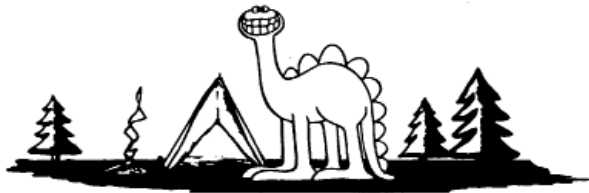

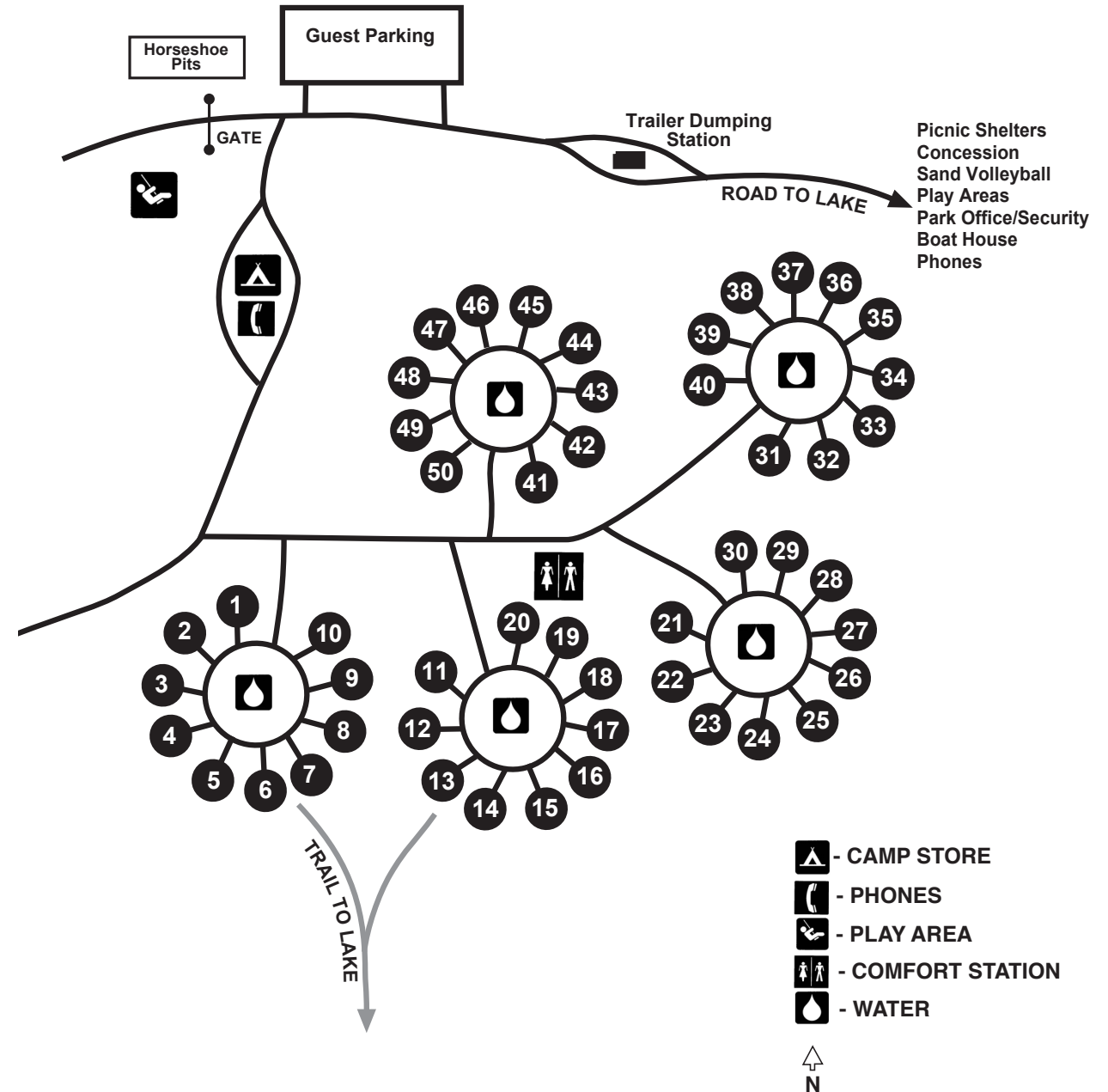

**Excerpts from Administrative Guidelines
as established by Local Law introduced
November 3, 1983.**

Family Camping

A. Check-out

1. After 11:00 AM one is liable to charge for one additional night whether the campsite is occupied for another night or not. All personally owned camping equipment shall be removed from the campground at the time the camper leaves. If a camper desires to remain in the park after the check-out time, he must break camp and move from the campground.

B. Control

1. The area security officer has the authority to assign sites. He may request the names of all members of the party to be recorded.

C. Equipment permitted

1. Equipment allowed on a tent or trailer site shall be limited to one (1) camping trailer or self-propelled camper, or tents and awnings not to exceed a combined total undercover of 275 square feet.
2. House trailers are not permitted.
3. All areas must be kept sanitary and clean at all times.
4. A maximum of two vehicles are allowed per site. Parking is not allowed on grass or roadways.

D. Double site assignment

1. In instances where it is necessary to assign large families to two sites for reasons of health or safety, they will be charged the rate of two sites.

E. Firewood

1. Firewood may be purchased at the campground.
NOTE: No person shall operate a chain saw within the park.
2. Firewood brought in from outside the park must comply with NYS DEC Regulations.

F. Guests

1. Visitors who are guests of campers may park their automobiles outside the campground in the parking lot. They will confine themselves to the camping area after the prevailing closing time set for day users and vacate the campground by 11:00 PM.

G. Minimum age

1. Persons under 18 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.

H. Occupancy

1. Campers must have their equipment present at the time of registration, occupy the site immediately and remain overnight.
2. Campers must notify the Park Manager if they plan to leave the campground for over twenty-four (24) hours.
3. For purposes of this section, a "day" begins and ends at 11:00 AM. Unless a camper sleeps overnight on the site at least once in forty-eight (48) hours, the Department may impound the equipment and remove it from the site. The site is then considered vacated and may be assigned to another camper.
4. No camping equipment shall be placed on any campsite while the site is occupied by another camper.
5. Substitution occupancy is permitted only after the site has been re-registered under the new occupant's name. Subletting is prohibited.
6. Occupancy of a campsite is limited to six (6) persons or one (1) family group consisting of parents and children (mother, father, and minor children and one single relative). In the case of large families (six or more) and when the campground is not crowded, the Commissioner at his discretion may assign two sites to one family.

I. Quiet Hours

1. Quiet hours will be observed from 11:00 PM to 7:00 AM. All noises, both human and equipment, will cease. Violators will be asked to vacate site.

J. Relocation

1. Campers desiring to move to another site will have priority over incoming parties. One move is permitted, and must be completed by 10:00 AM.

K. Registration

1. Campsites will be assigned if the park is running near capacity. Unless crowded conditions exist, the camper may be permitted to select his site.

L. Reservations

1. Reservations will be accepted after March 1st.
2. Reservations may be made at the Broome County Department of Parks and Recreation main office by calling (607) 778-2193. Full payment will be due upon registration at campground. Maximum of two sites per reservation. Reservation fee will be charged.
3. Reservations will not be accepted at the park.
4. Sites not reserved are available on a first come, first served basis. Persons arriving without reservations risk the possibility of not having a site available to meet their needs.
5. Reserved campsites must be occupied by 7:00 PM; there will be NO exceptions.
6. Broome County Department of Parks and Recreation reserves the right to assign a party to a site.
7. Reservations may only be made for one continuous period of stay.
8. All 50 sites are reserved on holiday weekends.

M. Services

1. Picnic table, trash barrel and a fire ring.

N. Season

1. Camping areas will be open mid May through Columbus Day weekend depending on local weather and existing area conditions.
Camping season: Thru May: weekends;
Memorial Day thru Labor Day: daily;
September thru Columbus Day: weekends.

O. Trenching

1. Trenching around camping units is prohibited.

P. Use

1. The use of camping sites, toilets, shower buildings, electricity, tables, fire rings, dump stations, etc. that are designated for the use of registered campers, are restricted to the use of the campers and their guests.

Q. Overflow

Will be permitted for people who arrive after the park closes. They will be quartered in the parking lot. They will leave the park by 8:00 AM the next morning and not be charged unless sites open up and they wish to extend their stay.

Group Camping

A. Group camping by organized youth groups only (such as churches, schools, YMCA, YWCA, etc.) will be permitted at Greenwood Park. A permit must first be obtained from the main office of the Broome County Department of Parks and Recreation.

E. One camping vehicle plus one transportation vehicle may be left in the Group Camping area at Greenwood Park per group for an emergency vehicle; all others will be parked in the parking lot. A list of license numbers will be given to the security officer in charge.
