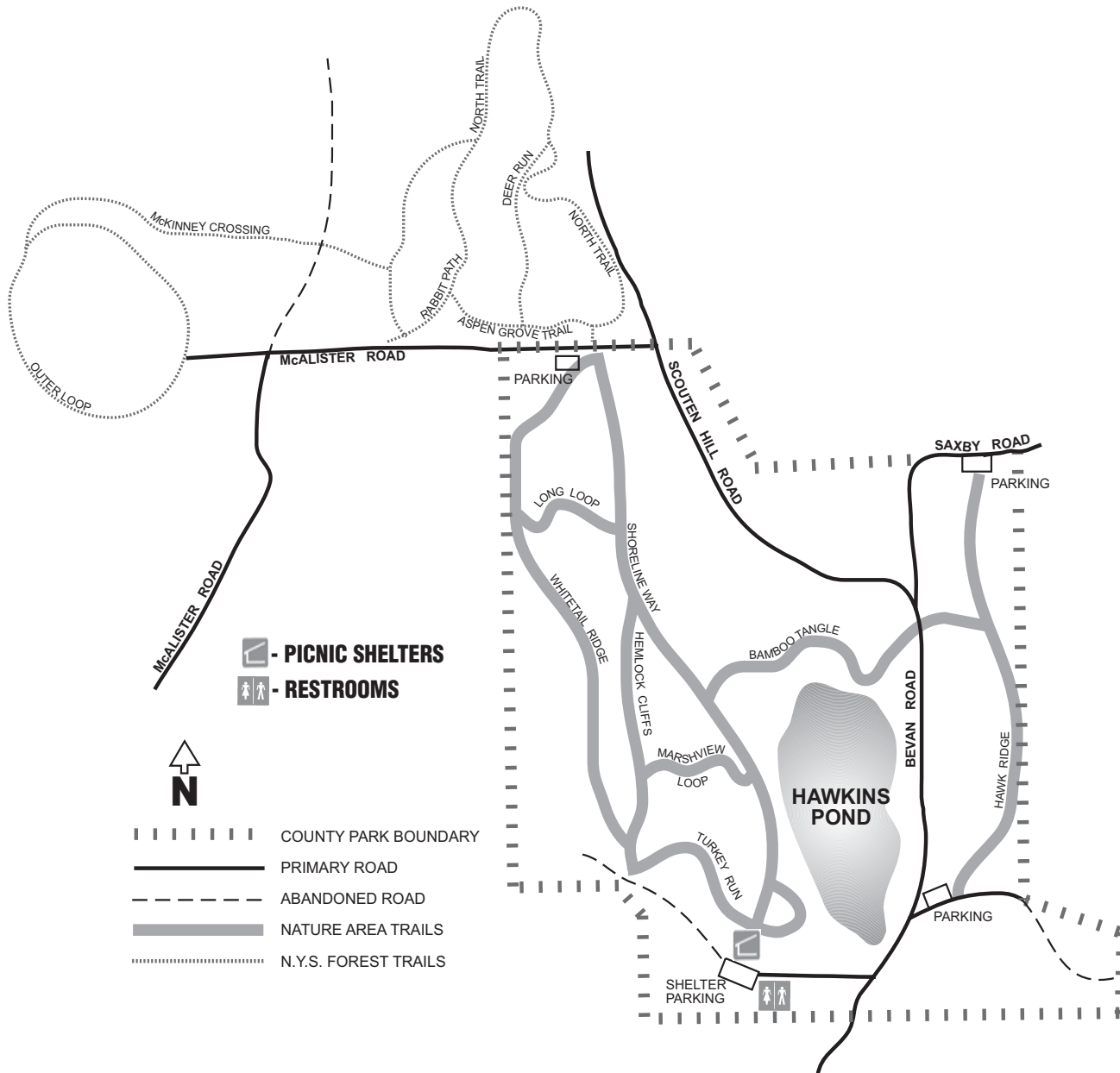


Hawkins Pond Nature Area Trails
