

Broome County Adult Homes

Adult homes provide 5 or more residents with rooms, meals, help with daily living and some degree of protective supervision. A resident may be provided assistance with the management of medications, but he or she must be alert enough to take their own medications. This is a lower level of care than nursing homes. These homes are licensed and monitored by the NYS Department of Health. Their website can answer a number of questions regarding this level of care by going to their home page and clicking on "Hospitals, Nursing Homes and other Health Care Facilities". Respite or short-term beds are available at some adult homes, (adult homes that have respite beds are indicated.) You may wish to explore this option if you or your family are providing care.

If you are considering an adult home for yourself or a family member, an assessment by CASA (Community Alternative Systems Agency), is recommended as a first step. This free in-home assessment will help you understand what type of home will best suit your needs. CASA may be reached at 778-2420.
