



NOTICE TO CLAIMANTS RECEIVING VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTER BENEFITS

If you are receiving weekly volunteer firefighter benefits, you must report any earnings you receive to the Broome County Office of Risk & Insurance. "Earnings" includes any cash, wages, or salary received from

1. self-employment
2. any employer other than the employer where you were injured.

"Earnings" also include commissions, bonuses, and the cash value for all payments received in any medium other than cash (e.g. a building custodian receiving an apartment rent free).

Failure to report earnings as defined will subject you to criminal prosecution and civil liability, including the suspension or forfeiture of your benefits.

Your endorsement on a benefit check, or deposit of the check into an account, is your statement that you are entitled to receive volunteer firefighter benefits. Your signature on a benefit check is a further affirmation that you have made no false claims or statements or concealed any material fact regarding your claim.
