

## **Supportive Housing Options**

**Updated: December 2023** 

A variety of alternative assisted living options are available to older adults in Broome County. It is important to consider the different types of living options and how they will meet your specific needs. Please consider the following different levels of care based on your needs.

## **Levels of Care Supportive Housing** Living in **Options** Assisted your own Skilled Family Type Homes for Adults Living home with Nursing within a Broome County Adult Care hired **Facility** assistance Family Homes for the Elderly

- **Family Type Homes for Adults** are smaller privately owned and operated family-like homes. They are licensed and inspected by New York State and are under the supervision of the Department of Social Services (DSS). These homes accept private pay. Some may accept Supplemental Security Income. For further information, you can contact Lisa Horbey at the Broome County Department of Social Services (607-778-3029). Any potential residents for this program should have a CASA evaluation (Call: 607-778-2420 option 2).
- Family Homes for the Elderly offer small family-style living for 1 to 2 residents in private homes. They provide meals, personal care, monitoring of medications, supervision, assistance with transportation medical appointments, housekeeping, laundry and socialization. The homes are overseen by The Family & Children's Society and only accept Broome County Medicaid as payment. A CASA evaluation and DSS review and approval is needed. • **Broome County Adult Homes** are larger facilities monitored by the NYS Department of Health. These homes provide 5 or more residents with rooms, meals, help with daily living, medications, personal care, housekeeping, laundry, structured activities, case management and some degree of protective supervision. These facilities accept private pay, and some may accept Supplemental Security Income (SSI).
