Barbara J. Fiala, County Executive:

The Department of Audit and Control has compiled a summary of the status of accounts receivable balances in various County departments as of September 30, 2006.

Our analysis of the data provided has revealed the following critical issues:

- The Aviation Department shows a 308% increase in the 31-60 day category. However, the outstanding amounts were paid in November and will be reflected in the 4th quarter aging report.
- The Health Department shows a 4915.3% increase in the 61-90 day category. This is the result of a \$17,695 increase in third party insurance billings for this category.

Attached are schedules summarizing the status of significant receivables as of September 30, 2006. The criteria that we established for monitoring was to track balances that were in excess of \$100,000 as of September 30, 2006 and generate from fee for service transactions. If you are aware of other receivable categories that are at risk of becoming uncollectible, please advise.
