The Department of Audit and Control has audited the payroll for the Health Department for the payroll period ended January 21, 2001. The audit was conducted in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards. Such standards require that the Department of Audit and Control plan and perform the audit to adequately assess the accuracy of the financial records and adequacy of the internal controls, and that we examine, on a test basis, sufficient, competent and relevant evidence to afford a reasonable basis for our conclusions.

Based on the results of our examination, it is our opinion that the Department of Health has complied in all material respects with existing rules, regulations, policies and procedures to properly monitor and record departmental payroll transactions.
