The Ad Hoc Committee on Redistricting Modifications meeting was called to order by the Chairman at 4:23 PM. The Committee took the following action with regard to the matters before it:

The Chairman announced the meeting was to address the Court decision relating to the Town of Maine and including prisoner population when drawing the Legislative District maps.

Mr. Martin read the NYS Municipal Home Rule Law Article 4, Section 34 which addressed the requirements of districts.

Mr. Weslar presented maps A, B and C for consideration. Mr. Reynolds addressed some of the reasons why he thinks these maps violate the requirements of the law.

Mr. Reynolds presented map D for consideration and explained the justifications of the districts. Following discussion, Mr. Flagg made a motion, seconded by Mr. Augostini to accept map D and forward it as the recommended map to the County Administration Committee of the County Legislature for consideration.
