

AD HOC COMMITTEE ON REDISTRICTING MEETING MINUTES
April 28, 2011

The Ad Hoc Committee on Redistricting of the Broome County Legislature met on Thursday, April 28, 2011 in the Legislative Conference Room, Sixth Floor, Edwin L. Crawford County Office Building, Binghamton, New York.

1. The Ad Hoc Committee meeting was called to order by the Chairman at 4:31 PM.

2. At the request from Mr. Keibel, Mr. V. Pasquale made a motion, which was seconded by Mr. D.J. Reynolds to approve the minutes of the April 26, 2011 meeting.

3. Mr. Keibel proposed a compromise Option 1-C which addresses some of the critical concerns that members of the Committee, such as Mr. Whalen, had and incorporated it with Option 1-A. At the request from Mr. Keibel, Mr. D.J. Reynolds motioned, which was seconded by Mr. Whalen to replace Option 1-A for Option 1-C.

Mr. D.J. Reynolds motioned, which was seconded by Mr. Howard to accept Option 1-C as the final recommended redistricting proposal.
Carried. Ayes-8, Nays-1 (V. Pasquale)
