1. WELCOME: Chairman Keibel

MISSION: The mission of this committee is to develop a proposal(s) for presentation to the County Administration Committee to redistrict Broome County's population by Legislative District to comply with (1) changes in population as the result of the 2010 census and (2) the will of the voters by reducing the number of Legislators from 19 to 15.
