Responding to a question, the District Attorney stated that the Assistant District Attorneys in his office currently hold the highest caseloads in the state. He further stated that the office currently has a total of 25 Assistant District Attorneys but that there should be at least 39 for the amount of cases his office prosecutes.

Responding to a follow-up question, the District Attorney stated that his office has begun testing a new DWI diversionary program that will continuously monitor eligible participants for alcohol consumption for 90 days.
