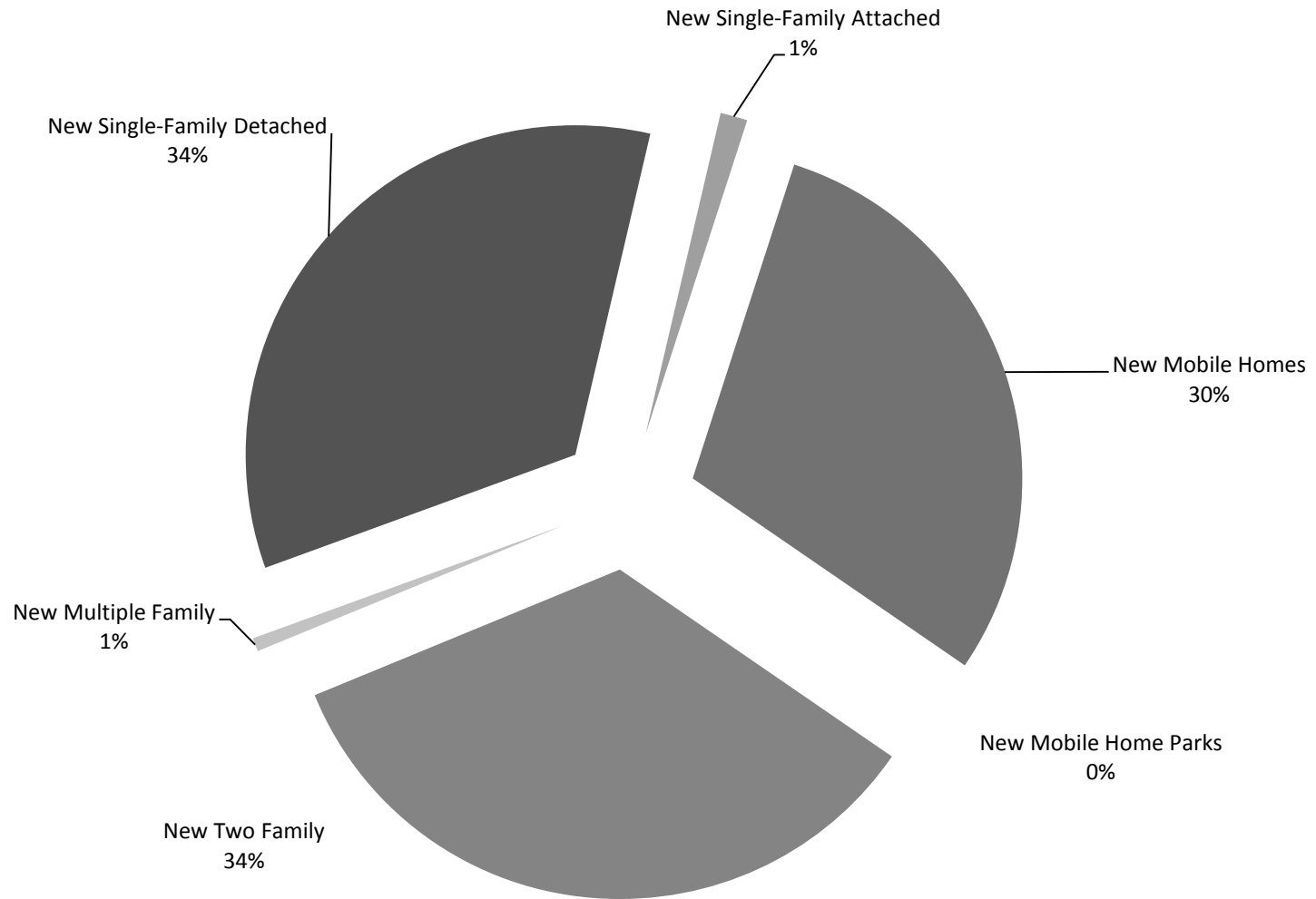

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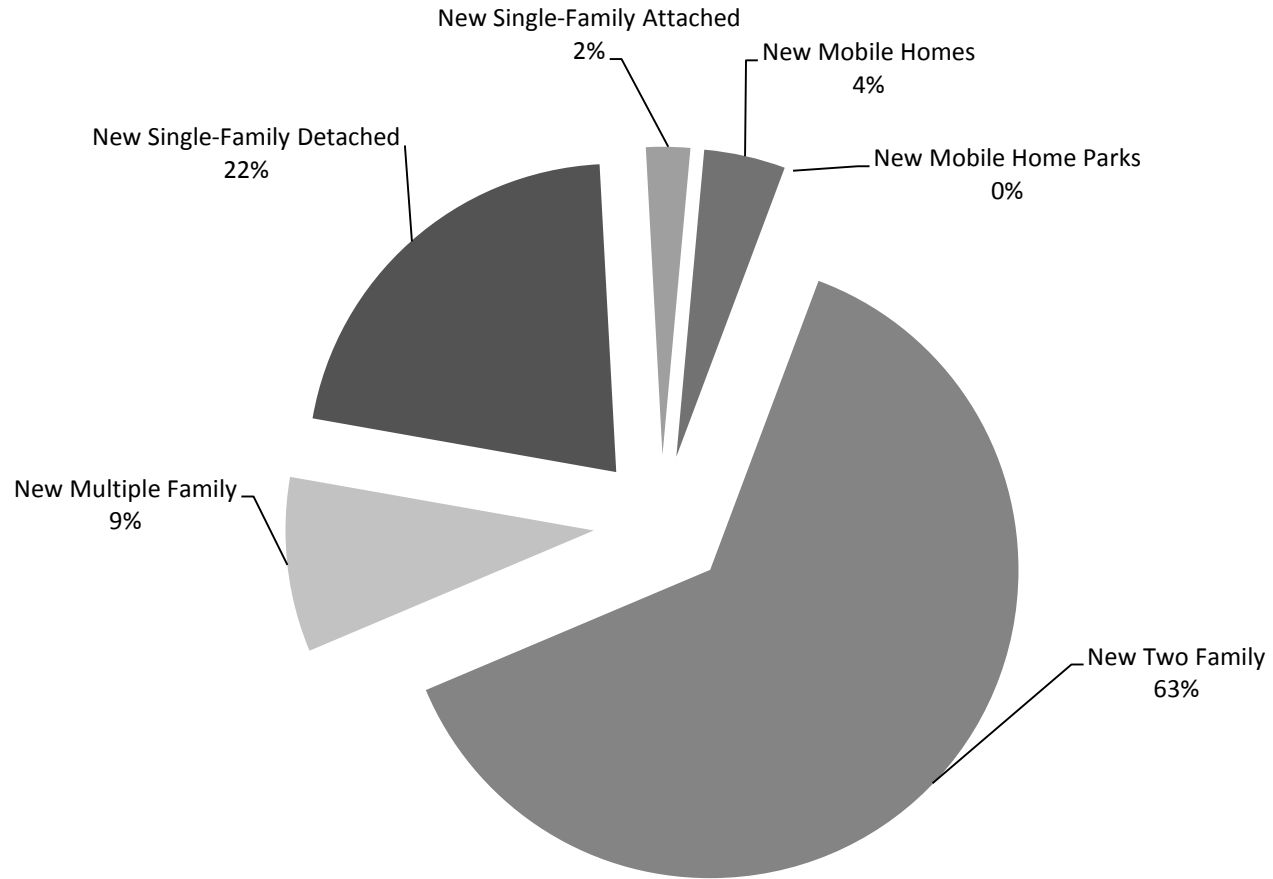
Countywide Permits Issued in 2015: New Residential Construction

Percentages Rounded to the Nearest Whole Number



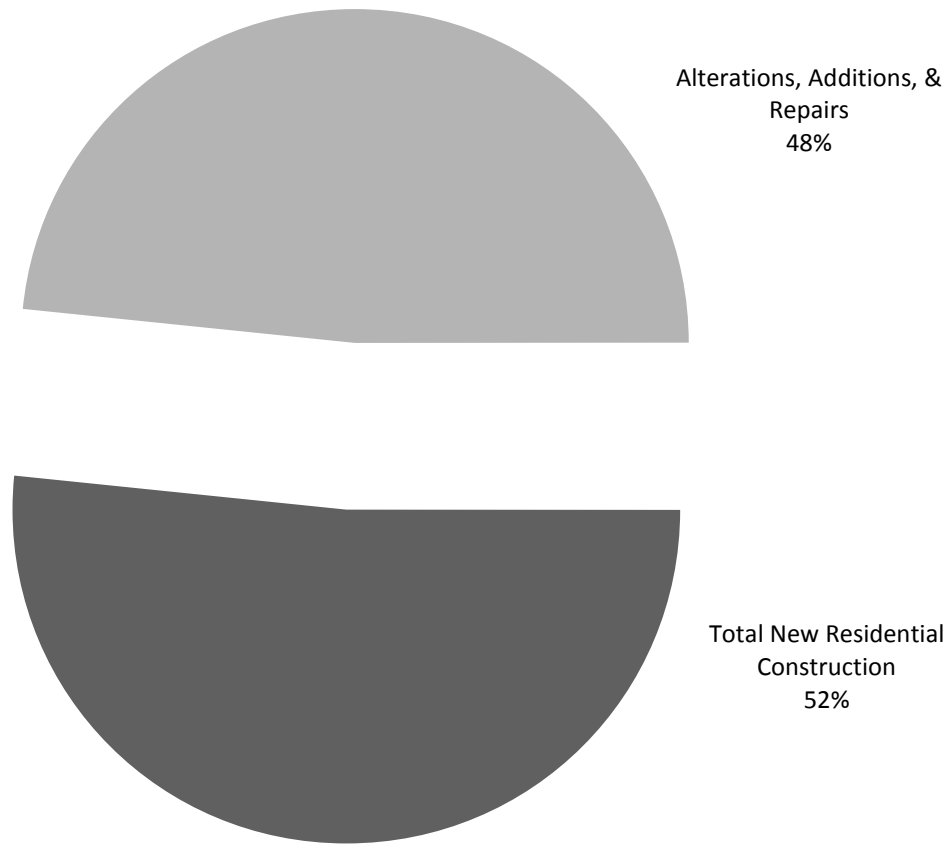
Countywide Value of Construction in 2015: New Residential Construction

Percentages Rounded to the Nearest Whole Number



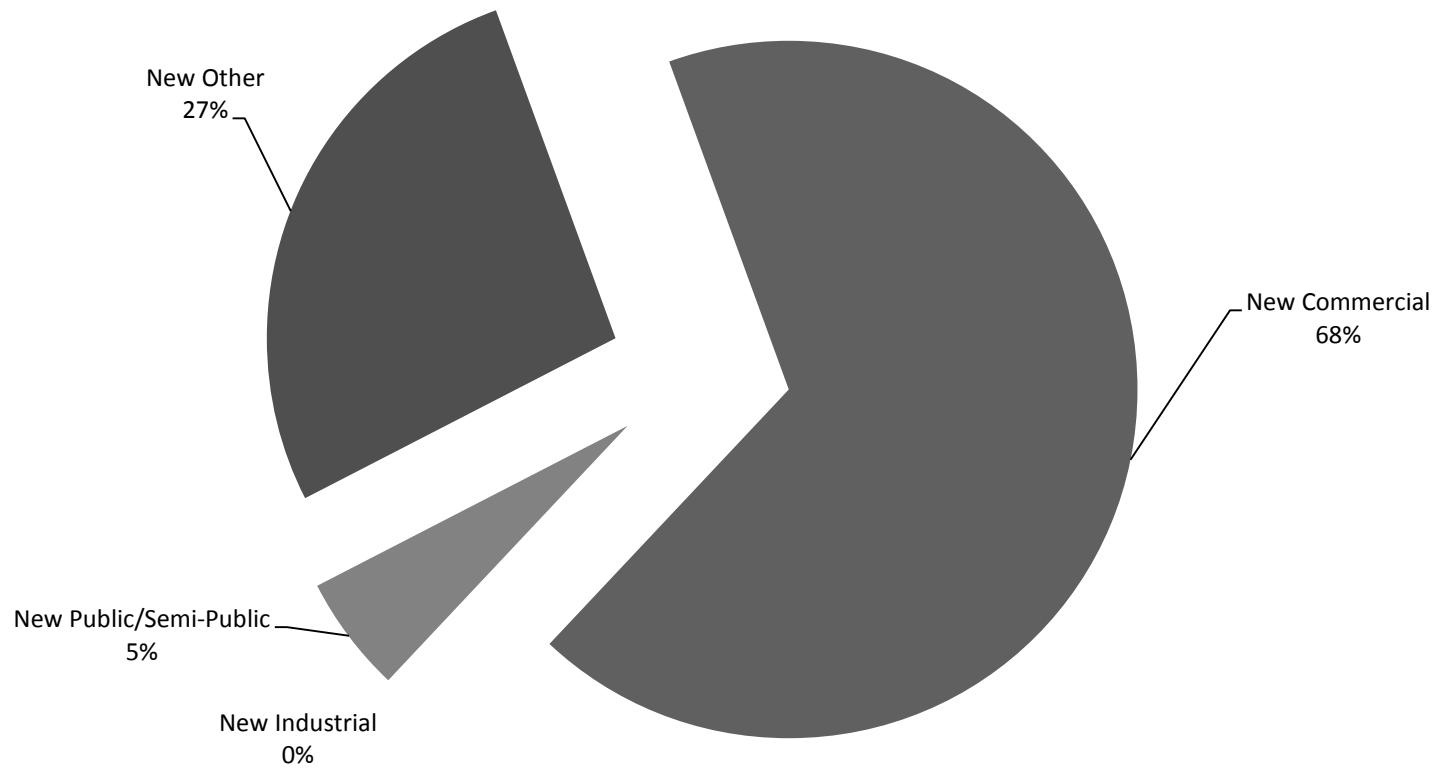
Countywide Construction Value in 2015: New Residential Construction and AA&R

Percentages Rounded to the Nearest Whole Number



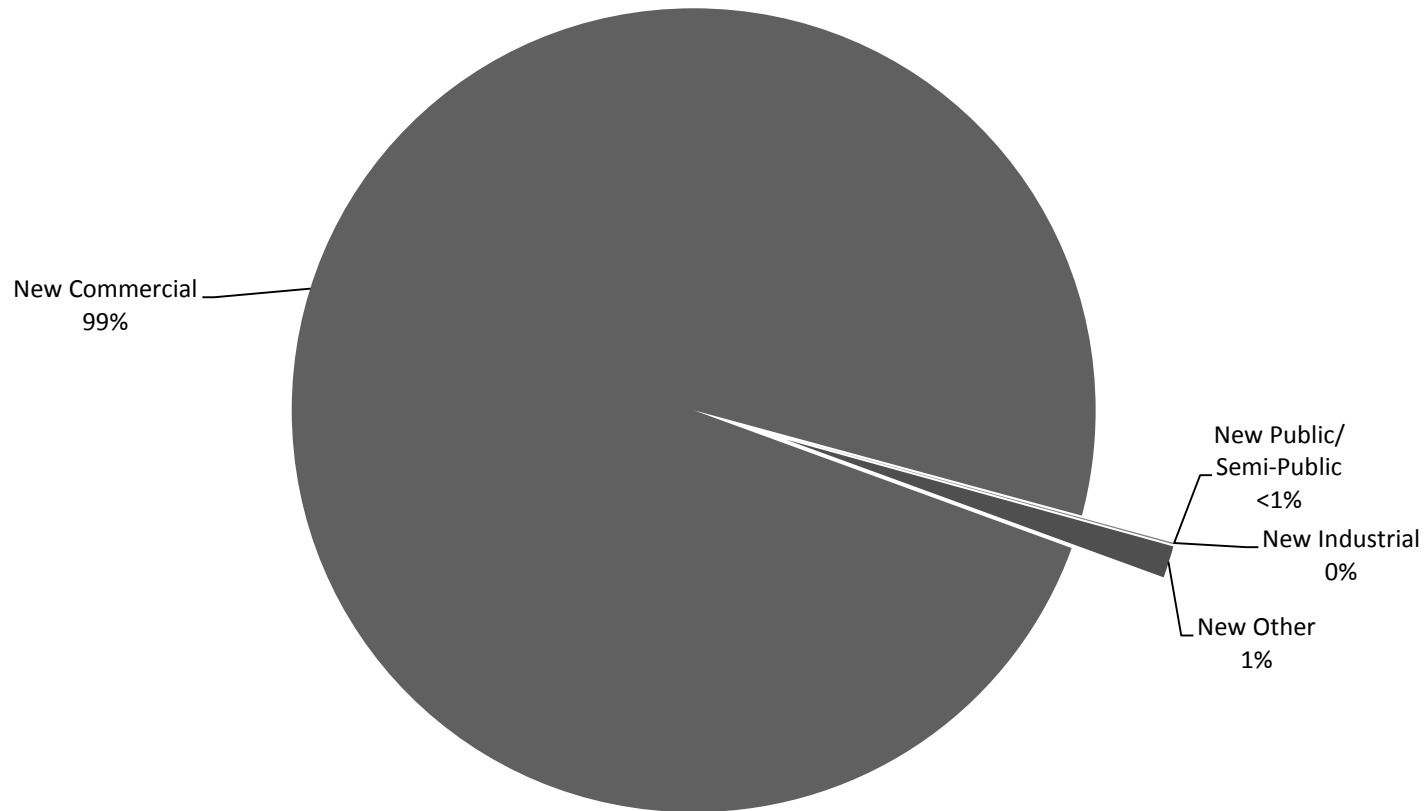
Countywide Permits Issued in 2015: New Non-Residential Construction

Percentages Rounded to the Nearest Whole Number

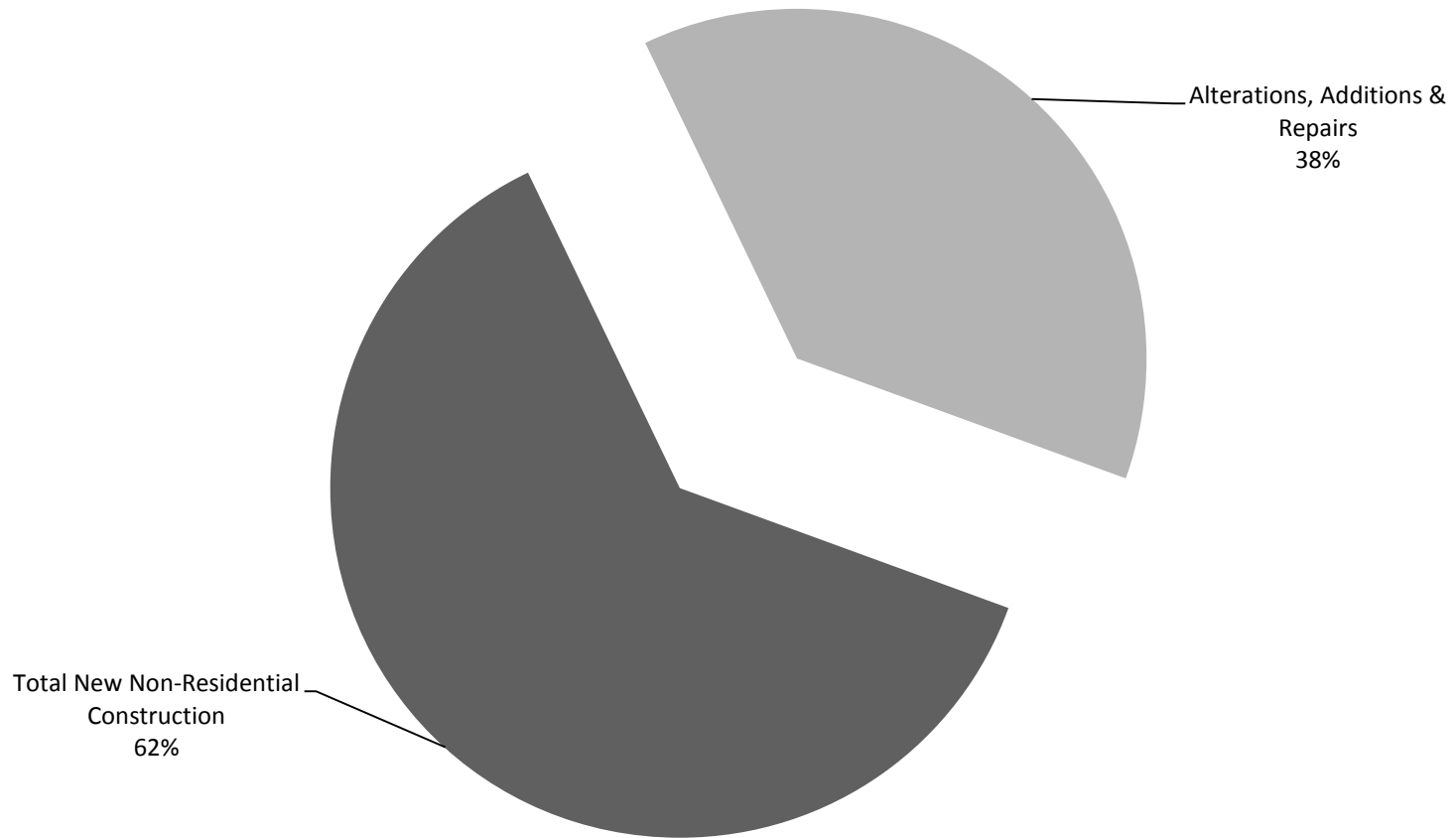


Countywide Value of Construction in 2015: New Non-Residential Construction

Percentages Rounded to the Nearest Whole Number

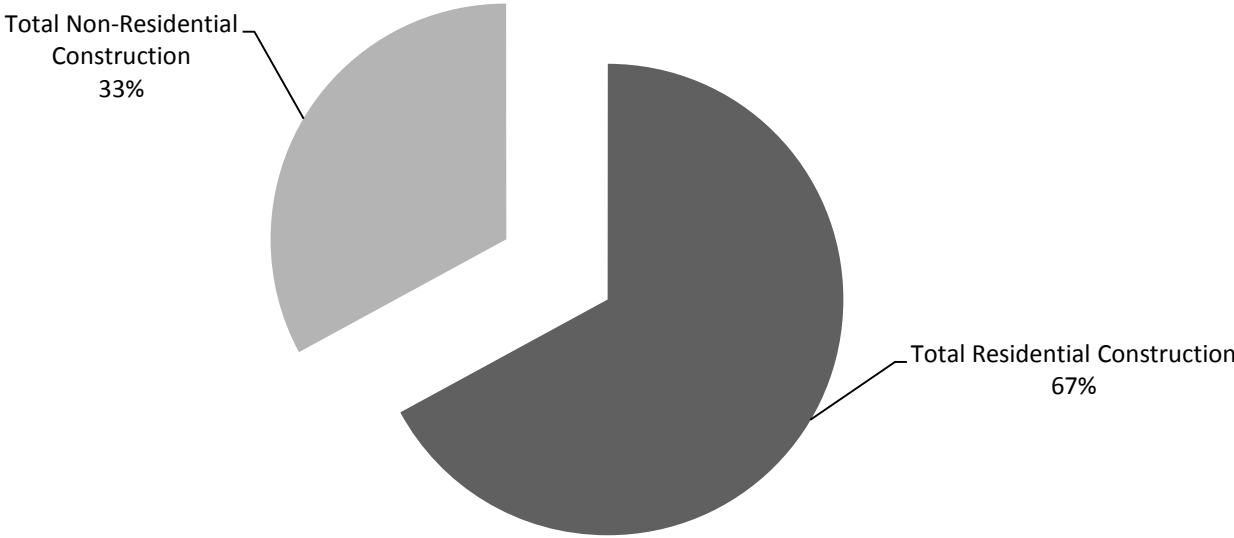


**Countywide Construction Value in 2015:

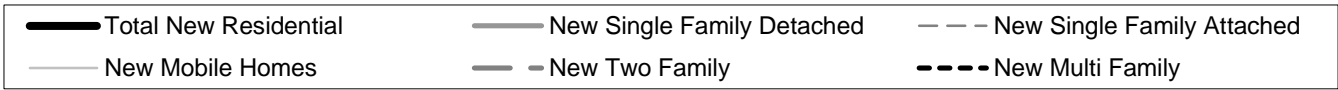
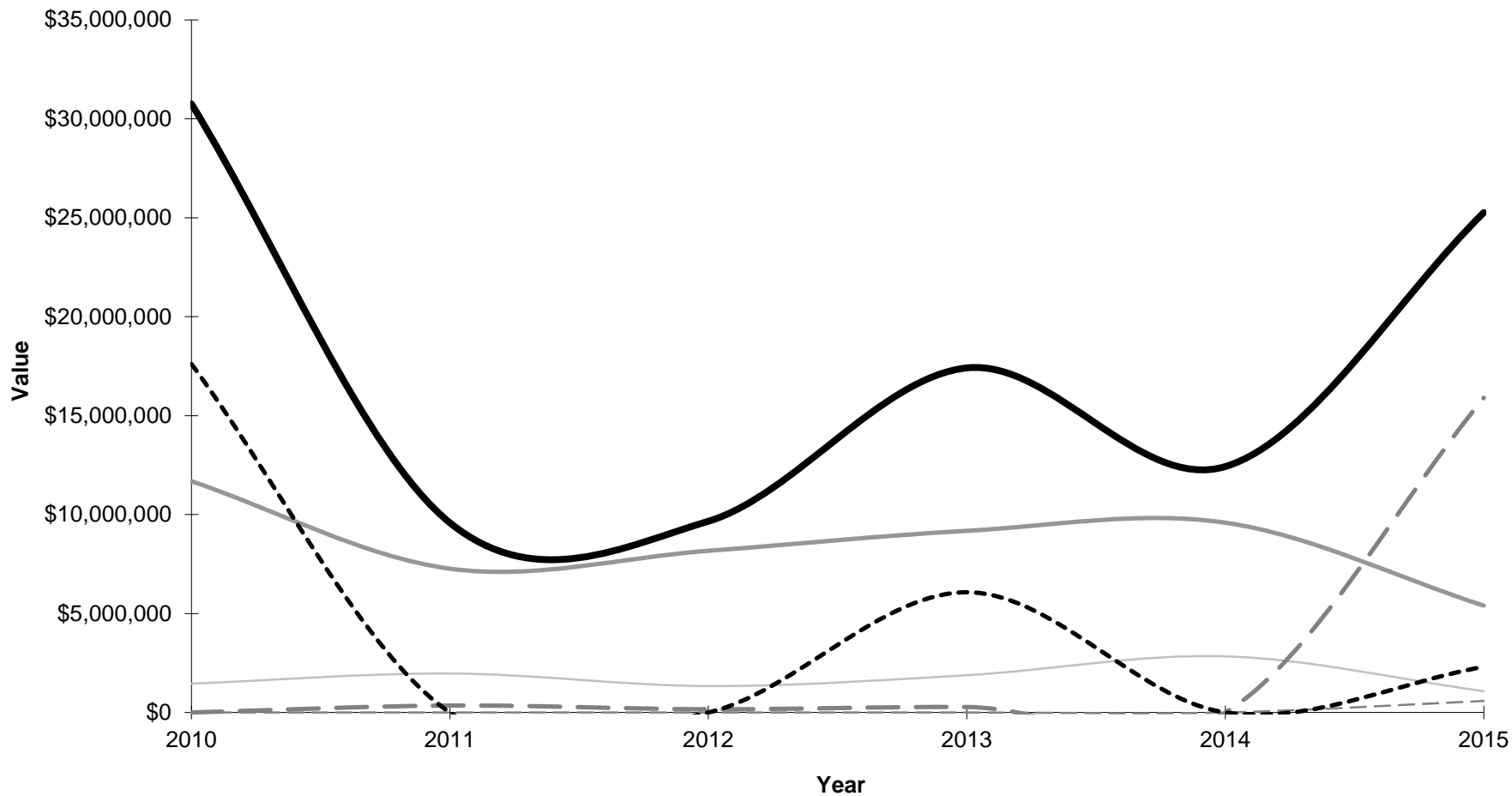

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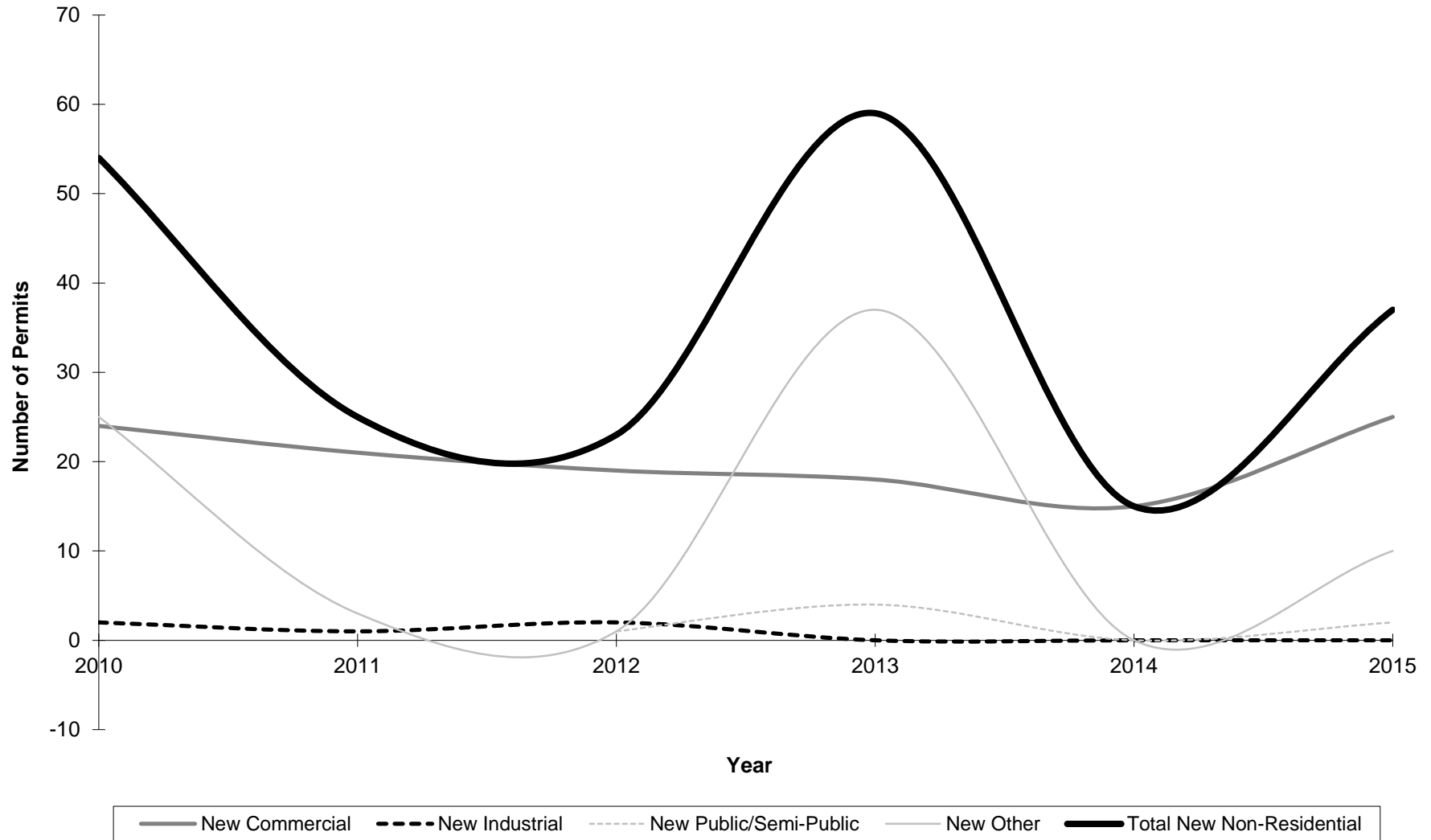
Countywide New Residential Building Activity: Five-Year Trend



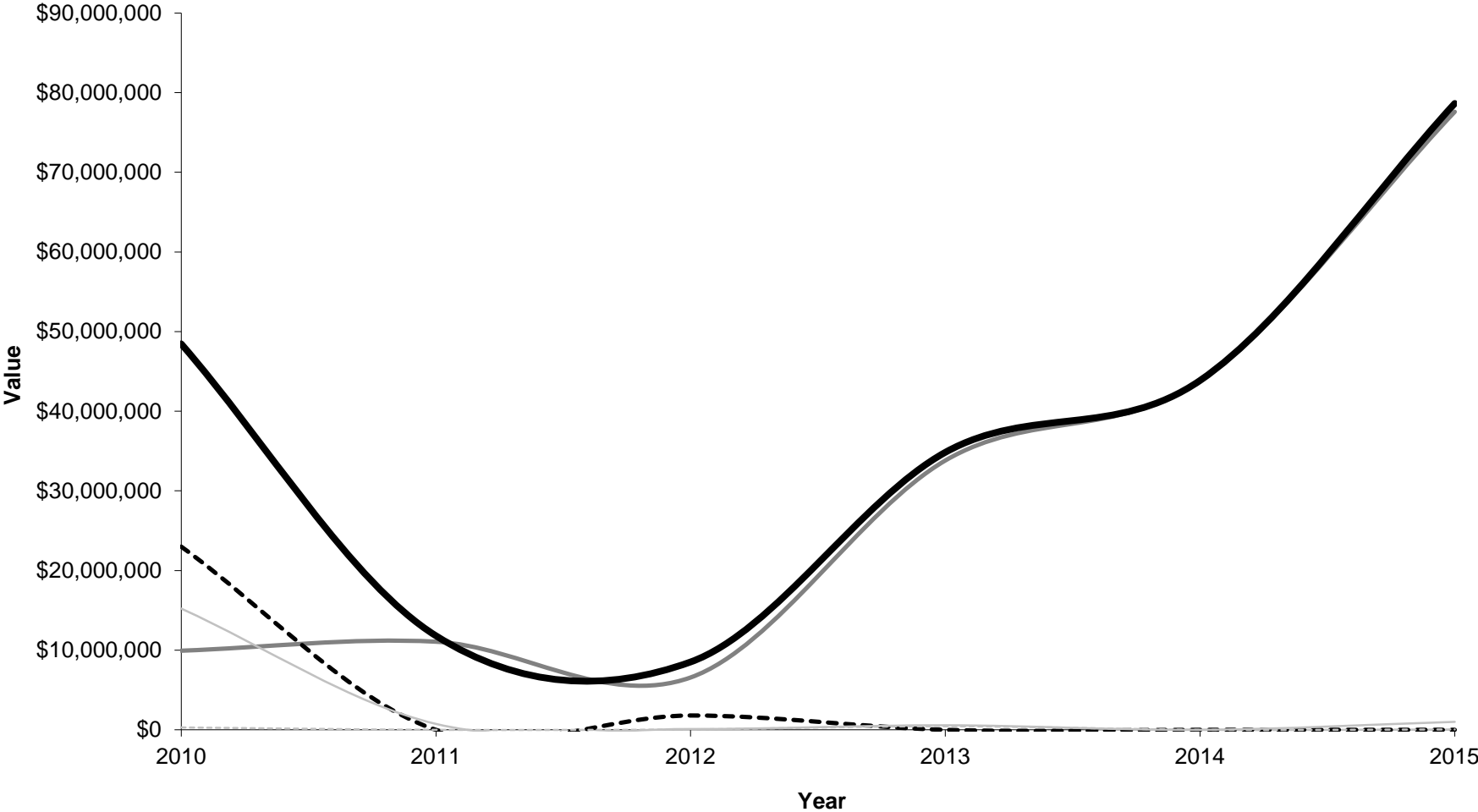
Countywide New Residential Value: Five-Year Trend

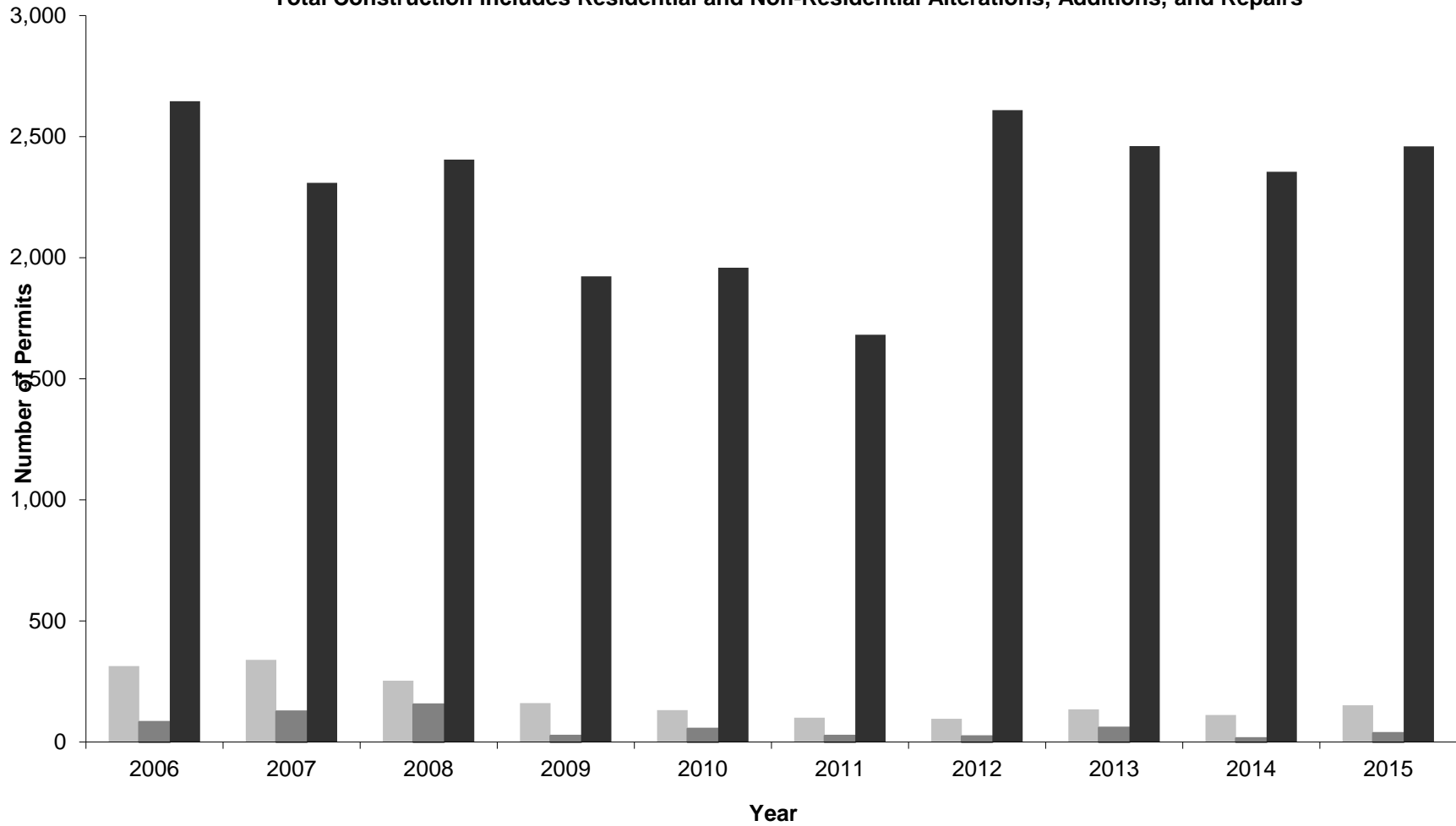

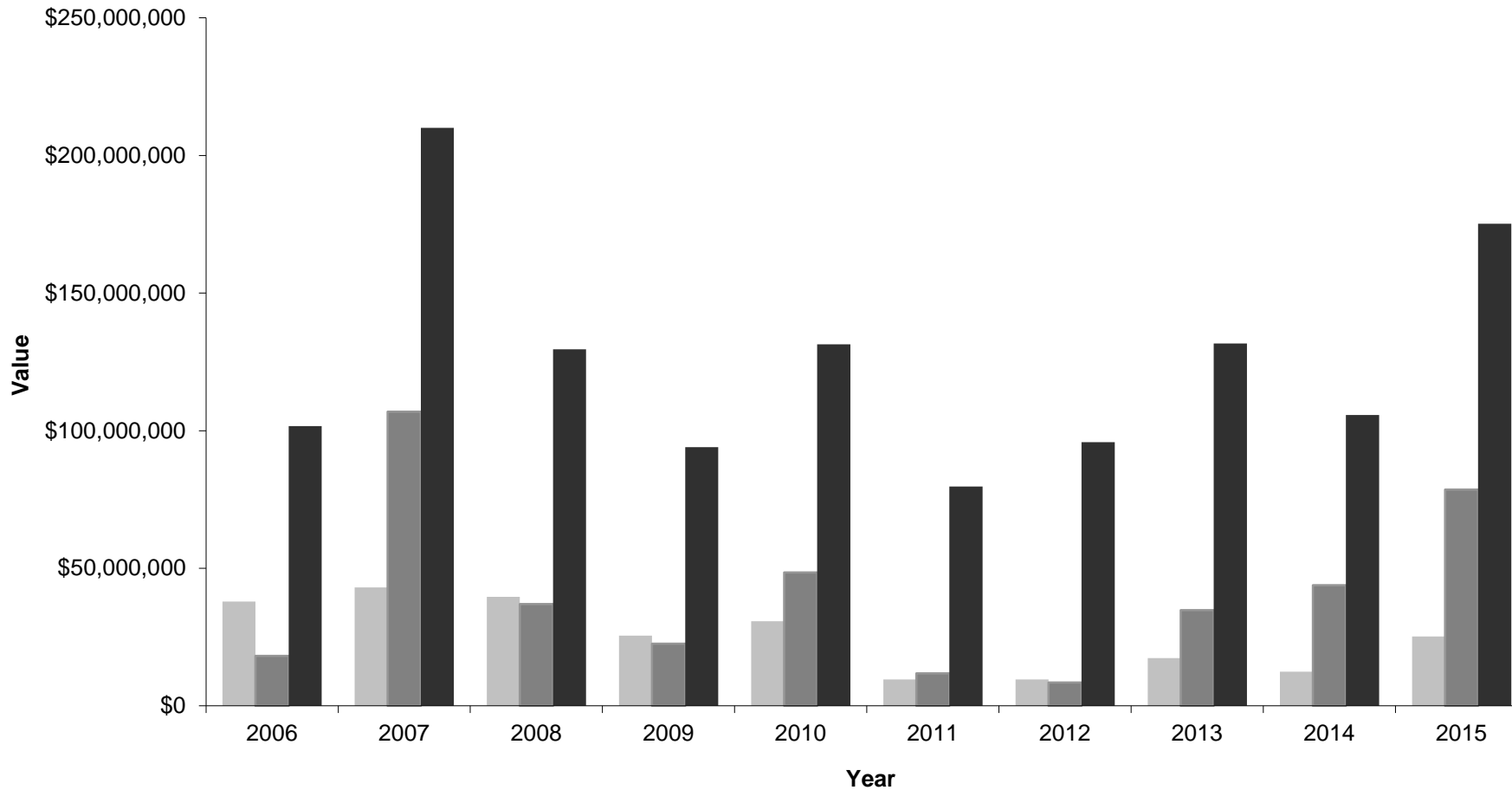
