
## Town of Windsor, New York Aging Demographics Fact Sheet



In 1990, residents 60+ made up 13.5% of the Town of Windsor population. This number increased to 23% in 2016. Between 1990 and 2016, the 60+ Town of Windsor population increased by 63%.
