## **Program Manager's Report**

- Current Foster Grandparent Status. Francie reported current Foster Grandparent Status. The program is currently at 32 active grandparents with 2 on a Leave of Absence.
- Outreach Efforts. Francie discussed the latest outreach efforts made by the Foster Grandparent staff. Field Supervisor Robin has been to several tabling events and has made numerous connections with potential foster grandparents. Nancy E. assisted at a UE school tabling event to help promote the program. There are several events coming up and Robin will reach out to members to assist at those events. Joan and Donna agreed to assist at Northern Broome Senior Center tabling event on Grandparents Day in August.
