The Broome County Sheriff's Office Detective Division has arrested Mark A. Torres, a 27-year-old male, from the City of Binghamton. Torres is being accused of stealing credit cards from two separate vehicles in the Town of Conklin and attempting to use one of the stolen credit cards at a retail store in the Village of Johnson City. As result of the investigation Mark A. Torres was charged with five (5) counts of Grand Larceny in the 4th Degree, all Class E Felonies, one (1) count each of Criminal Possession of Stolen Property in the 4th Degree and Identity Theft in the 2nd Degree, both Class E Felonies and one (1) count of Petit Larceny a Class A Misdemeanor.

Torres was processed for arrest and released on appearance tickets to answer his charges at a later date.

Date of Crimes: May 12th, 2021

Date of Arrest: May 17th, 2021

Charges:

Five (5) Counts of Grand Larceny in the 4th. Degree Class E Felonies

One (1) Count of Criminal Possession of Stolen Property in 4th Degree a Class E Felony

One (1) Count of Identity Theft in the 2nd Degree a Class E Felony

One (1) count of Petit Larceny a Class A Misdemeanor
