**On June 2<sup>nd</sup> 2021 at approximately 1000 hours, members of the Broome County Sheriff's Office responded to the area of Airport Road and CFJ Blvd. in the Town of Dickinson, for a male attempting to steal a vehicle that was stopped at a red light. The driver of the vehicle was stopped at a traffic light on Airport Road at CFJ Blvd when the male jumped into the back seat of his vehicle and demanded to be taken to Elmira. The driver instead decided drove to the Binghamton University Library Annex at 10 Gannett Dr and took the keys from the ignition. The suspect then demanded the keys from the victim but was unable to get them. The suspect was last seen walking away from the scene up onto the highway. When patrols arrived in the area, they were directed to Route 17, near exit 71 where the male was located nearby and detained for further investigation. The suspect, Matthew T, Longwell, 28, from Elmira, NY was subsequently arrested and transported to the Broome County Sheriff's Office for processing. Matthew was charged with Attempted Robbery 2<sup>nd</sup> and dropped off to the Broome County Sheriff's Correctional Facility to await arraignment at CAP.**
