The Broome County Sheriff's Office made the following arrest yesterday.

At about 8:19 PM on Tuesday, July 27, 2021, Sheriff's Office personnel observed a vehicle, a blue Chevrolet pick-up truck, pass a stop sign without stopping while traveling on Market Street in the Town of Dickinson. Upon conducting a traffic stop Deputy Zielewicz interviewed the driver, identified as 46 year old Degardo Newborn. While speaking with him, Deputy Zielewicz detected an odor of an alcoholic beverage on Newborn's breath. Upon further investigation, Newborn displayed other signs of intoxication including bloodshot, watery eyes. Newborn was administered a series of field sobriety tests which he performed poorly on. Newborn was arrested under the suspicion of driving while intoxicated. An open container of an alcoholic beverage was located inside the vehicle. Newborn was transported to the Sheriff's Office headquarters for further investigation and arrest processing. While at the Sheriff's Office, Newborn was asked to provide a sample of his breath. He provided the sample and was found to have .11% blood alcohol content. Newborn was released on appearance for the offenses listed below. He was directed to appear in the Town of Dickinson Court at a later date. The Chevrolet Pick-up truck was towed from the scene of the traffic stop.

Arrested: Degardo Newborn, 46, of Binghamton, NY

Charges: NYS Vehicle and Traffic Law and NYS Penal Law:

Failure to stop at a Stop Sign, a violation

Driving while intoxicated, an unclassified misdemeanor

Operating a motor vehicle with more than .08% of 1% or more of alcohol, a misdemeanor

Aggravated unlicensed operation 3rd degree, a misdemeanor
