On November 29, 2021 at about 6:29 pm Broome County Sheriff's Office deputies observed a vehicle matching the description of a vehicle being sought by the New York State Police traveling eastbound on State Route 17 in the Town of Union. Deputies attempted to perform a traffic stop and the vehicle, a 2006 Volvo, would not pull over. A vehicle pursuit ensued that lead to the Village of Johnson City. While driving east on Riverside Drive at a high rate of speed the operator, later identified as Daniel Klenchik, lost control of the vehicle and struck a telephone pole. Klenchik exited the vehicle and fled the scene of the accident on foot. He was located a short distance away by deputies. Klenchik was charged with the offenses listed below. He was issued tickets returnable to the Village of Johnson City Court. Klenchik was turned over to the New York State Police for their investigation.

Arrested:
