







BROOME COUNTY SPECIAL INVESTIGATIONS UNIT TASK FORCE

PRESS RELEASE June 4, 2021

The Broome County Special Investigations Unit Task Force executed a narcotics search warrant today at a local motel on East Main Street in Endwell, Town of Union. Eladio M. Murphy, Adam R. Rogers and Watasha D. Young were arrested after Task Force investigators located;

- 4.2 Grams of Fentanyl
- a quantity of Crystal Methamphetamine
- a quantity of Cocaine
- approximately \$1,576 in suspected drug sale proceeds
- digital scale and packaging materials used for weighing and packaging narcotics for sale

The Task Force was assisted on scene by a marked patrol unit from the Broome County Sheriff's Office.

Murphy, Rogers and Young are all currently being held at the Broome County Sheriff's Correctional Facility pending arraignment at the CAP arraignment court.

Arrestee 1: Eladio M. Murphy, 37, 2603 East Main St. Endwell, NY

Charges: One count of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree, a Class B Felony, One count of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 4th Degree, a Class C felony, and two counts of Criminally Using Drug Paraphernalia in the 2nd Degree, class A Misdemeanors.

Arrestee 2: Watasha D. Young, 34, Endwell, NY

Charges: One count of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree, a Class B Felony, One count of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 4th Degree, a Class C felony, and two counts of Criminally Using Drug Paraphernalia in the 2nd Degree, Class A Misdemeanors.

Arrestee 3: Adam R. Rogers, 38, Homeless

Charges: One count of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree, a Class B Felony, One count of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 4th Degree, a Class C felony, One count of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 7th Degree, a Class A Misdemeanor, and two counts of Criminally Using Drug Paraphernalia in the 2nd Degree, class A Misdemeanors.

The Broome County Special Investigations Unit Task Force is comprised of members of the Broome County Sheriff's Office, the City of Binghamton Police Department, the Village of Johnson City Police Department and Village of Endicott Police Department.
